2024 MoPac Mixed Doubles Rules

1. *WCF Curling Rules shall apply to all games. (WCF competition broomheads/pads are not required.)*
2. *Games will be 8 ends in length with game tie-breakers decided by draw to the button for non-playoff, quarterfinals, and semifinals games and a full extra end for the finals. There will be no tied games.*
3. *The two players in charge of the house (non-delivering player) will agree on proper action in case of any rule violation. If unable to agree, the event coordinator will direct proper action.*
4. *Measurements shall be done by the playing teams.*
5. *A game clock will be provided for every draw, set to 1:30. Clock will start when all games in the draw have put a stone in play. If the game clock expires during an end, that end shall be finished. No further ends will be played except in case of a tied score (see rule 2).*
6. *For non-playoff games, teams will flip a coin prior to the start of the game. Winner will have choice of stone placement (A/B) or stone color. The other team will make the remaining choice.*
7. *For playoff games, the higher ranked team gets choice of stone placement (A/B) or stone color except if both teams are from the same qualifying group (A, B, or C) then they will still need to flip a coin for choice.*
8. *Competition Format: the format will be triple knock-out with an 8-team playoff bracket.*
9. *Playoff format: Playoffs will be single elimination. Teams losing a quarterfinal will be eliminated. Teams losing a semi-final will play a game to determine 3rd place (Bronze).*
